

FINANCIAL SUMMARY


For the years ending December 31, 2016 and 2015

Despite the turbulent times we are living in, The Dressage Foundation's investments provided satisfactory results for the past year. Our investments produced a 10.5% total rate of return for 2016, while providing a compounded annual return rate of 6.6% over the past three years, and 9.0% over the last five years.
