- Are you now training in Europe at the time you are applying for the Lindgren Scholarship?

### 3. Tell us why you should be selected for the Lindgren Scholarship.

### 4. Financial planning information:

- Do you plan to take your own horse/s?
- Provide a line item pro-forma budget of the estimated costs to fulfill your training plan.
- What amount are you requesting from The Major Anders Lindgren Scholarship?
- Do you now, or will you be requesting funding from other sources?
- If yes to the above funding sources, how much additional will you seek?

## 5. Your Training Plan/Clinician(s):

- Please request to each of your recommendation writers that they send 6 copies of their comments to YOU. It is up to you to include these in your packet of information to the Foundation. **DO NOT HAVE RECOMMENDATIONS SENT DIRECTLY TO THE FOUNDATION.**

## 7. Signature:

- Please sign where indicated on the Application Cover Page, that if chosen as the recipient for the Major Anders Lindgren Scholarship, you will meet the requirement to write a written report of your training experiences in Europe, to include a financial summary, and send to The Dressage Foundation within the time frame specified. You will also need to attest that you are a citizen of the United States.
- Your written report will be on the Foundation's website along with a digital photograph. If chosen, you will arrange that a digital photo be taken and sent to the Foundation. This report is to be sent to the Foundation no more than three months after you have returned from training.
